

Abrego Gas Line Project



Due to increased demand for natural gas in our area Southwest Gas has found it necessary to install a new gas main from the 500 block of South Abrego to the 200 block of North Abrego. From Abrego it will turn eastward on East La Flecha to the Haven Golf Course and proceed eastward where it will cross under the Santa Cruz River and connect to a major gas main on the east side. This project will provide improved reliability for natural gas supply in our area.

The main is being placed under the southbound lane of Abrego near the west curb. During construction all Abrego traffic is being confined to the east side of the median. All access to homes will be maintained. The gas main will be bored under Esperanza to avoid traffic problems.

When the work is completed, scheduled for March, the southbound "golf cart/bicycle" and "parking" lane will be re-paved. As we all know, the paving on Abrego is in very poor condition and this may result in some improvement to the shoulder lane. But the necessary use of heavy equipment during construction and the increased traffic on the northbound lane could degrade the existing paving..
